Purpose: Goals of the Survey

Learn about the SJC implementation phase activities, challenges, and experiences from the perspective of local stakeholders in 19 SJC sites from the first and second cohorts

Methods: Web Survey Administration

- Stakeholder list developed with help from site coordinators (N = 237)
- 2018 recruitment process and administration
 - 9/19: Survey opened & link emailed to stakeholders
 - 11/5: Survey closed
 - 183 survey responses (77% participation rate)
- RTI aggregated responses across the implementation sites to ensure confidentiality of respondents

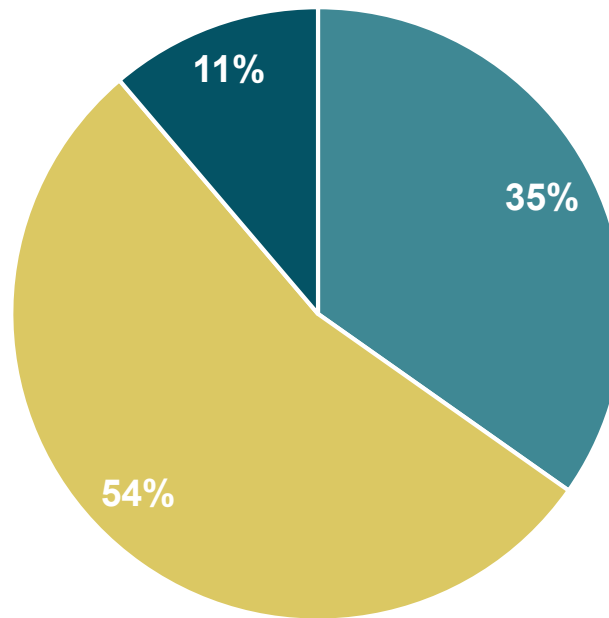

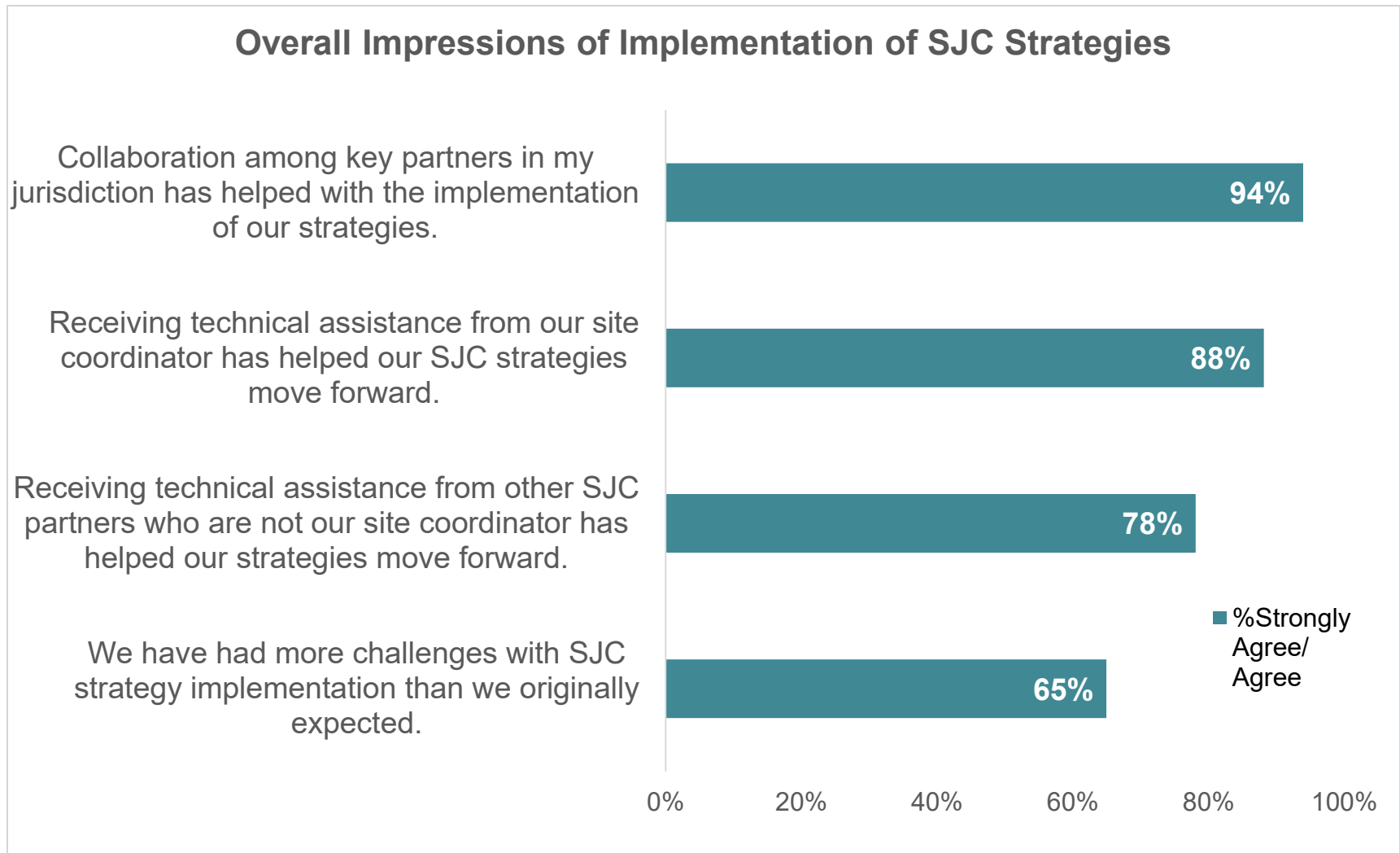

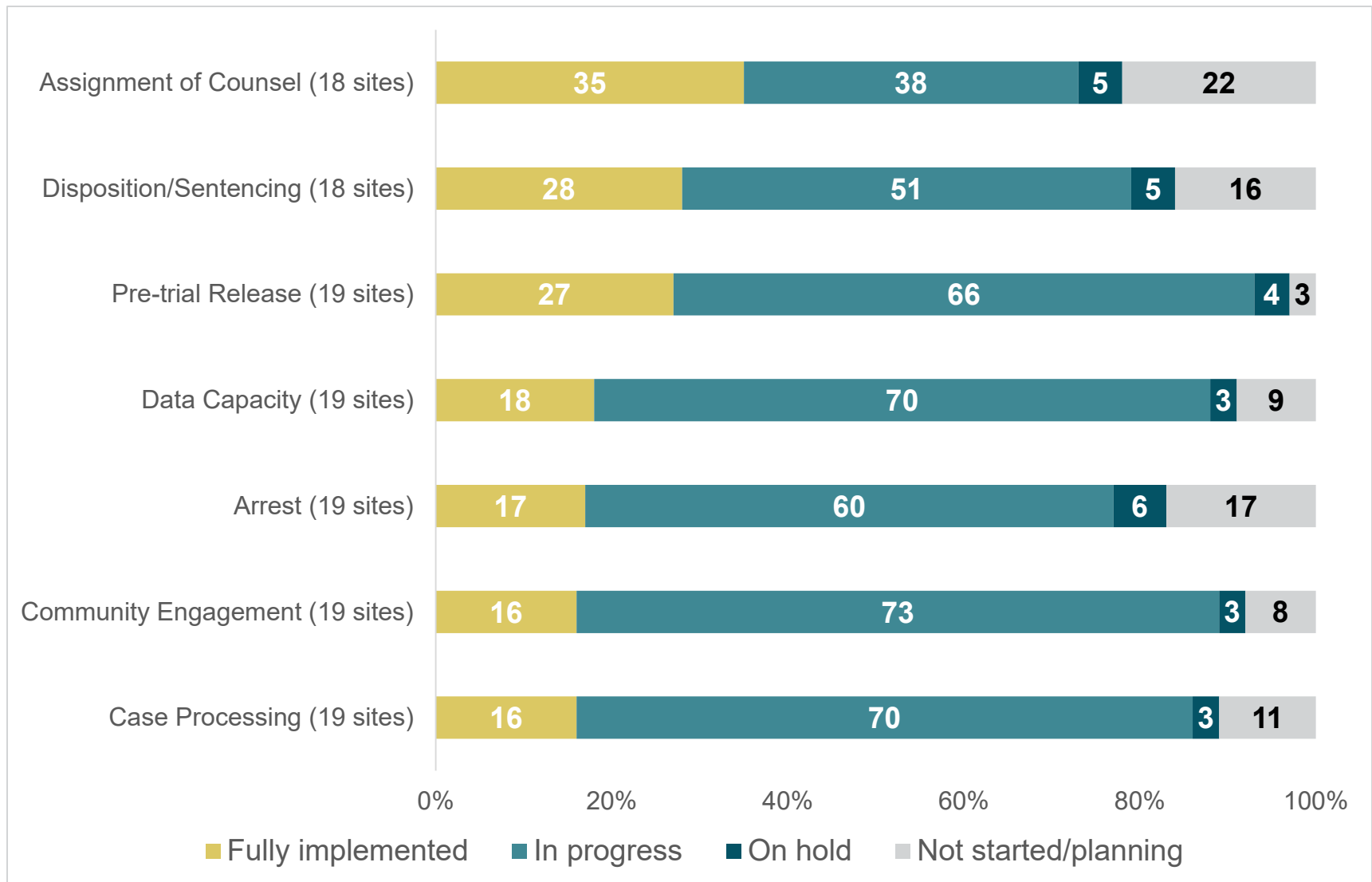


Status of SJC Strategies

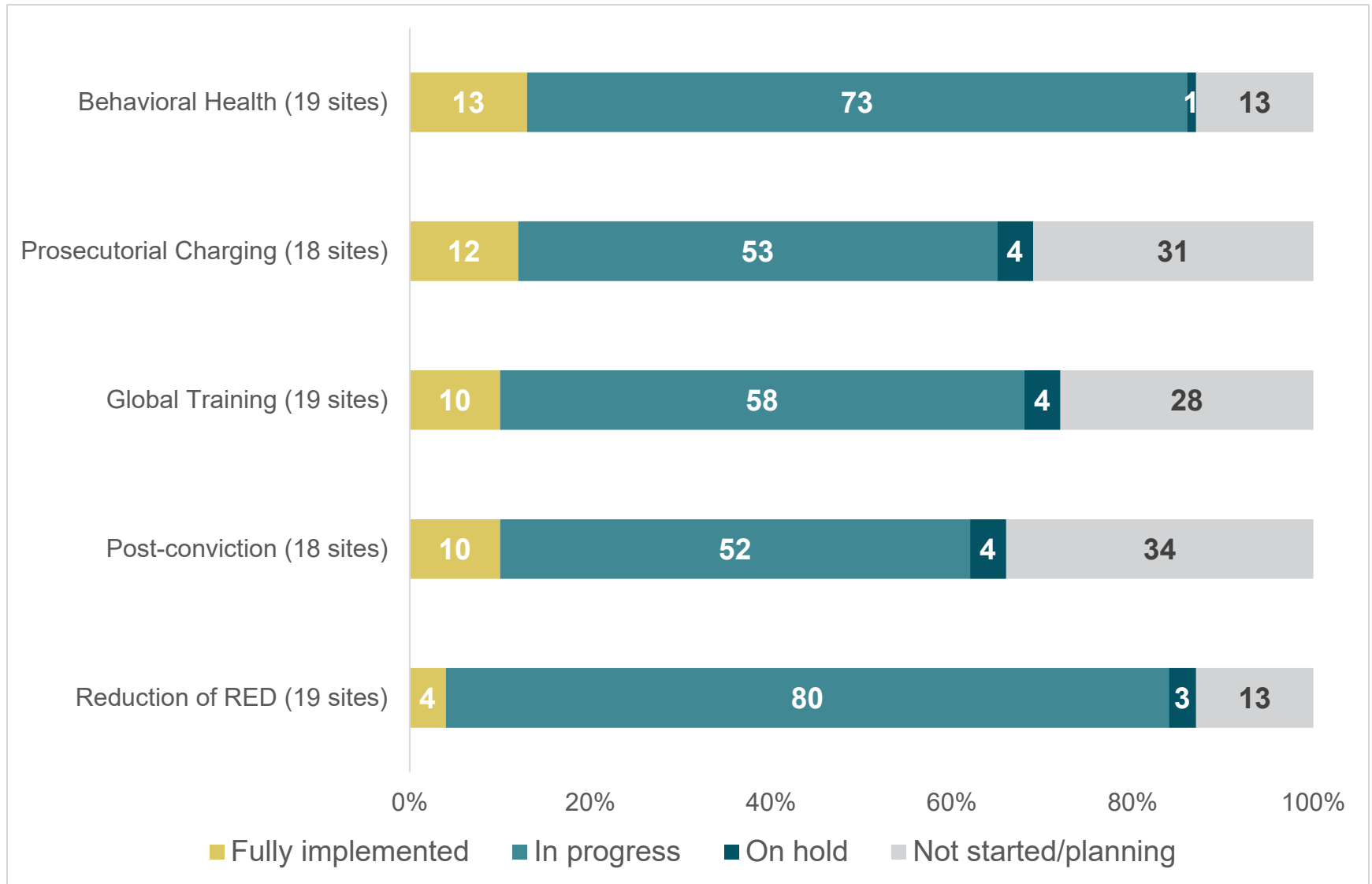
Please think of the strategies that are being implemented in your jurisdiction and indicate the current status of each one according to the decision point or topic to which it corresponds. The status indicators are as follows:

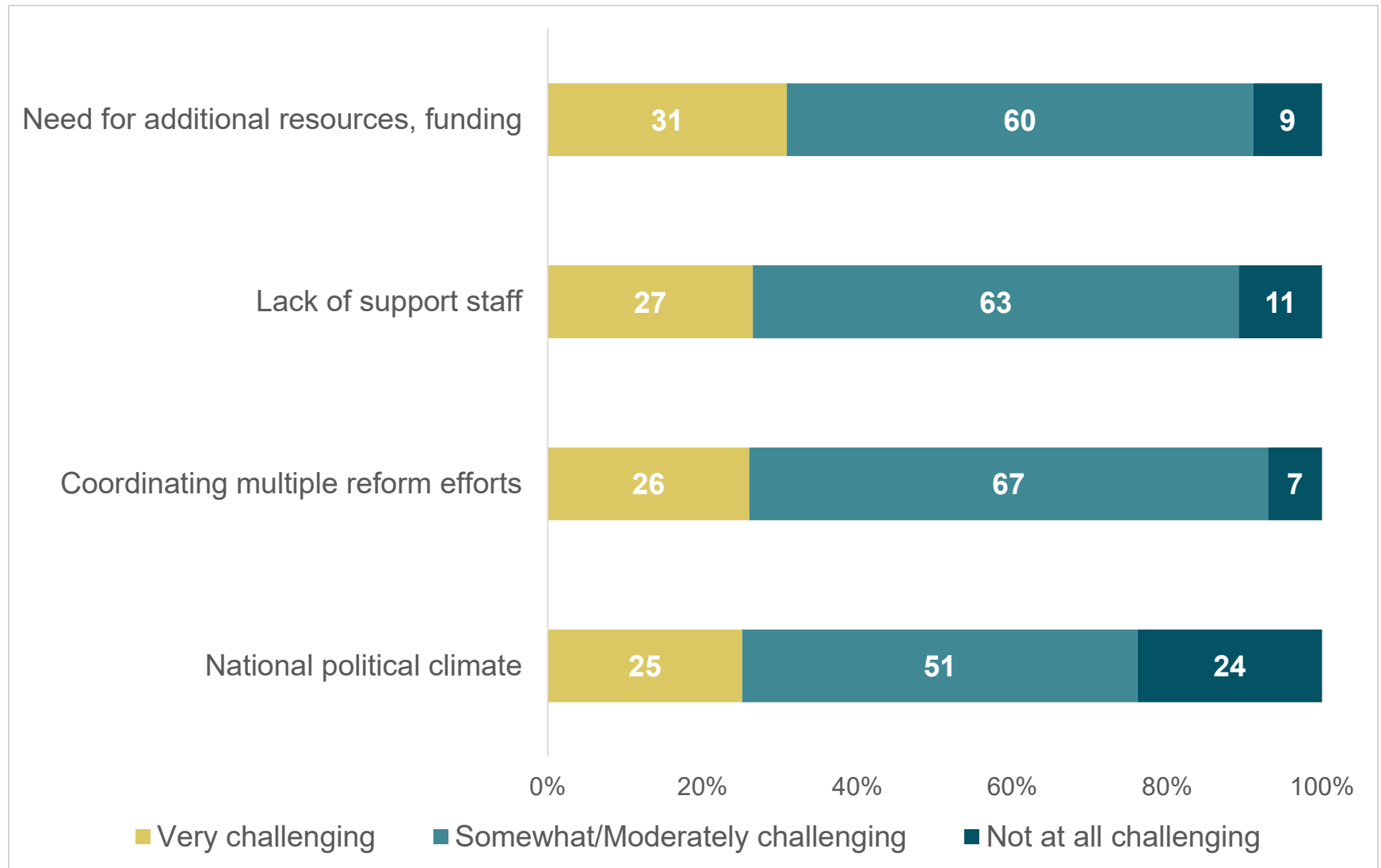

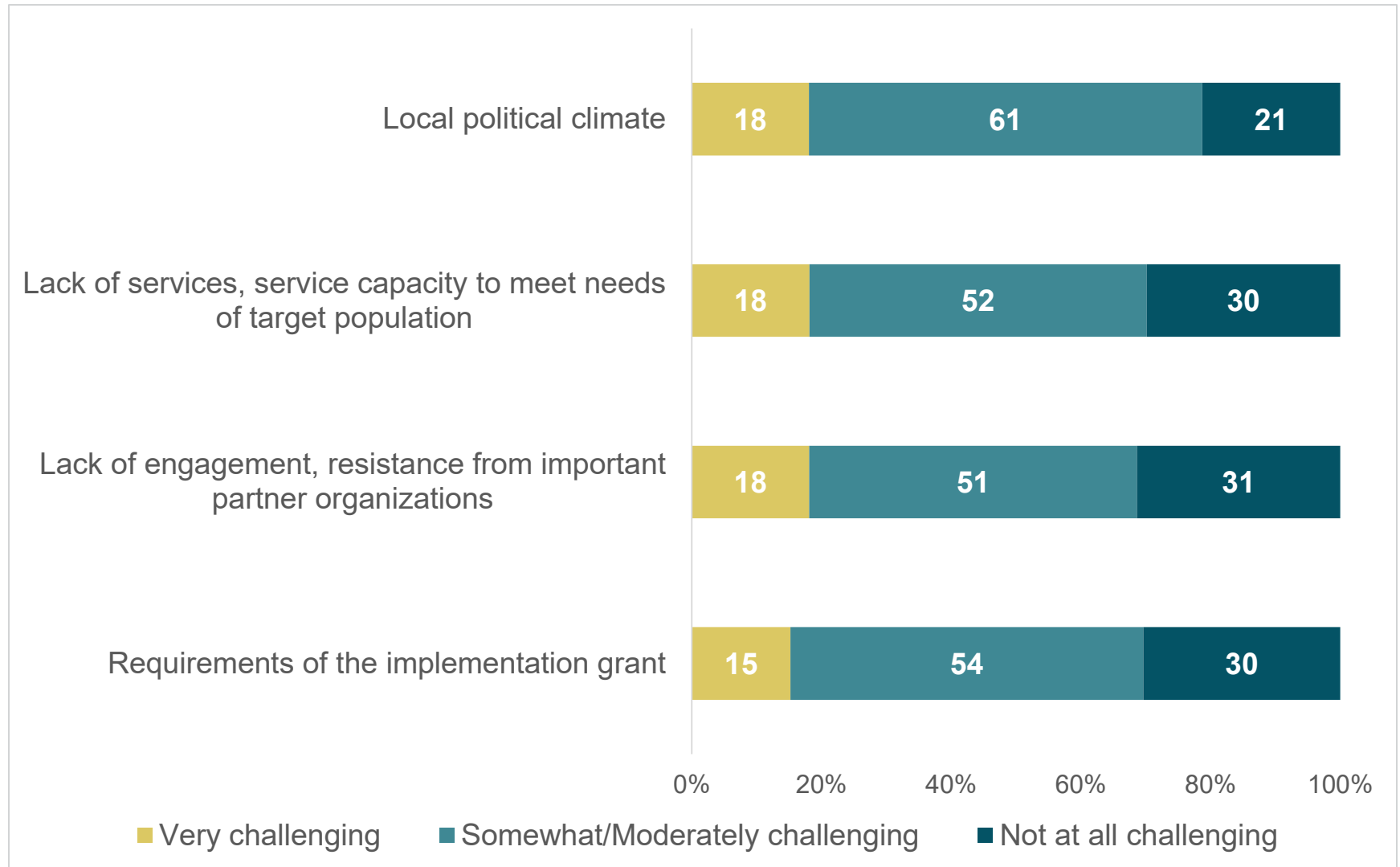

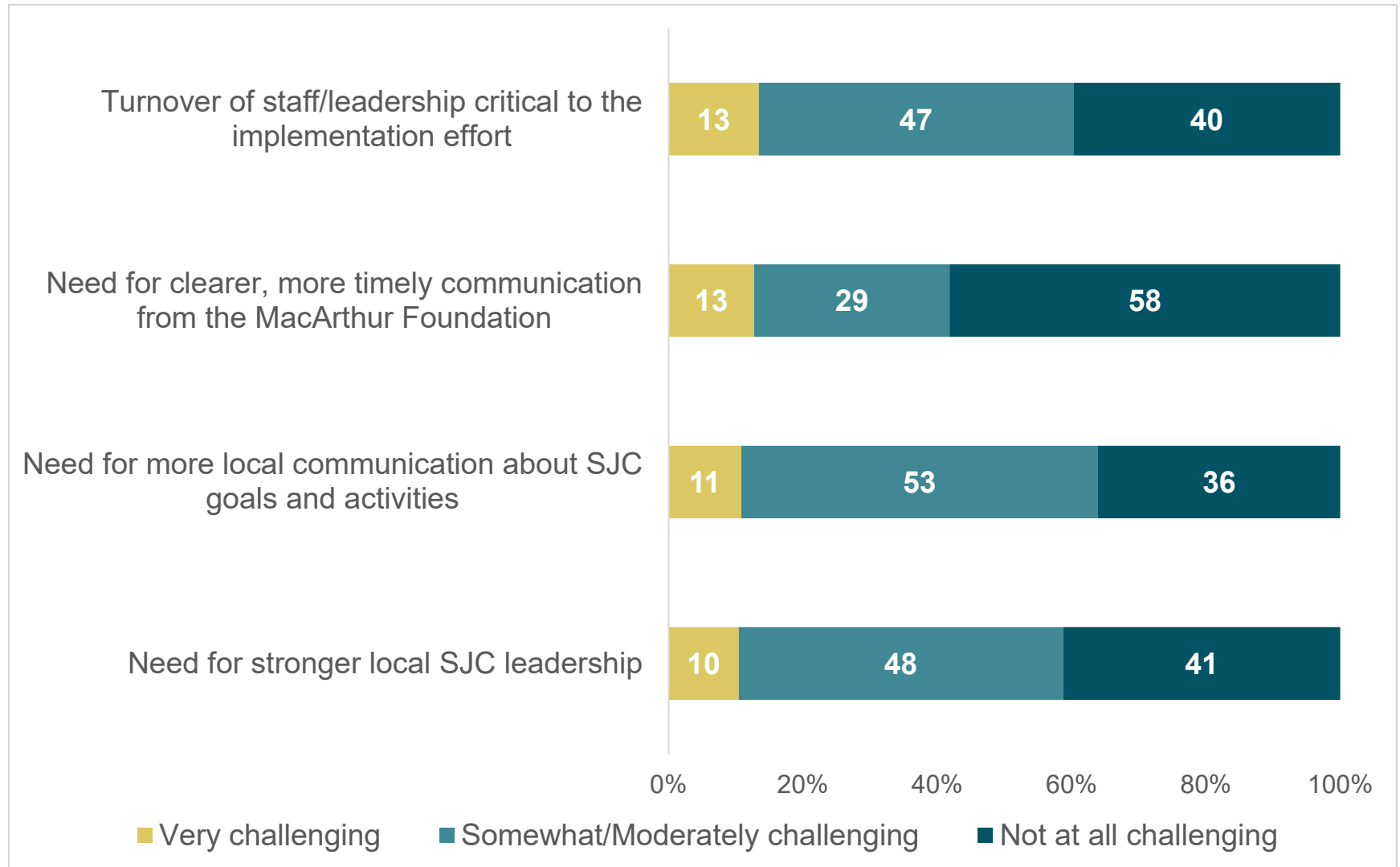

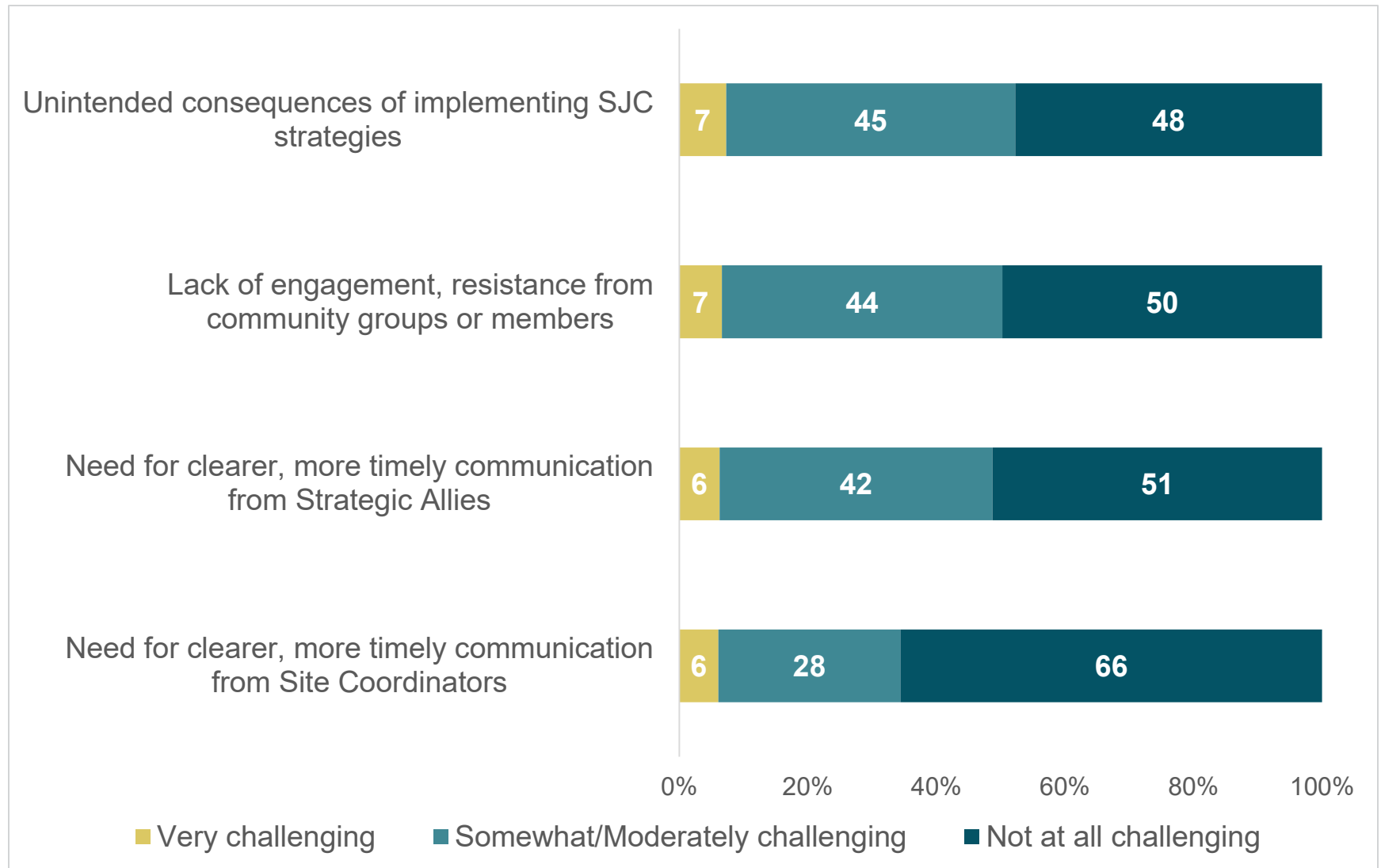

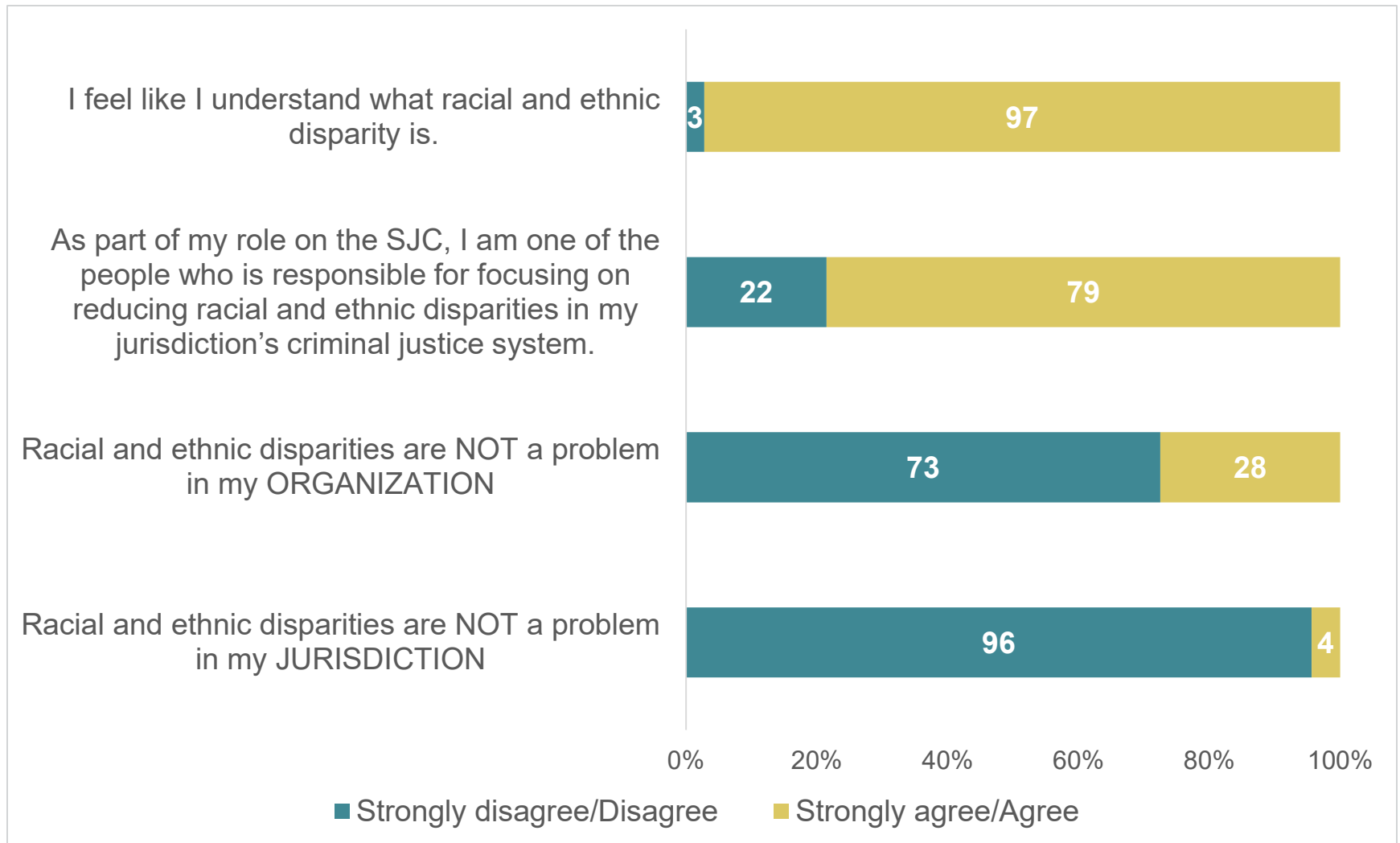

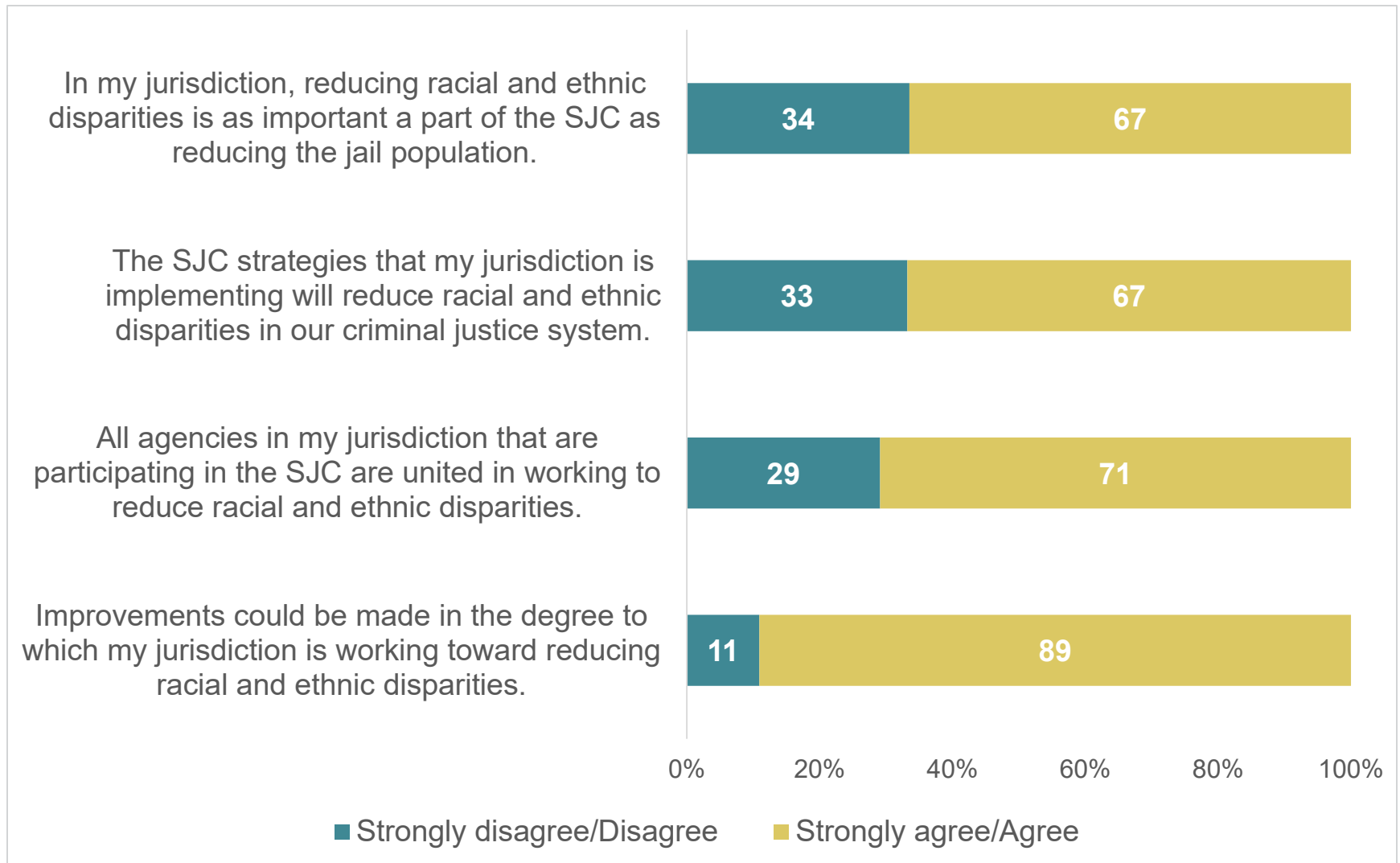

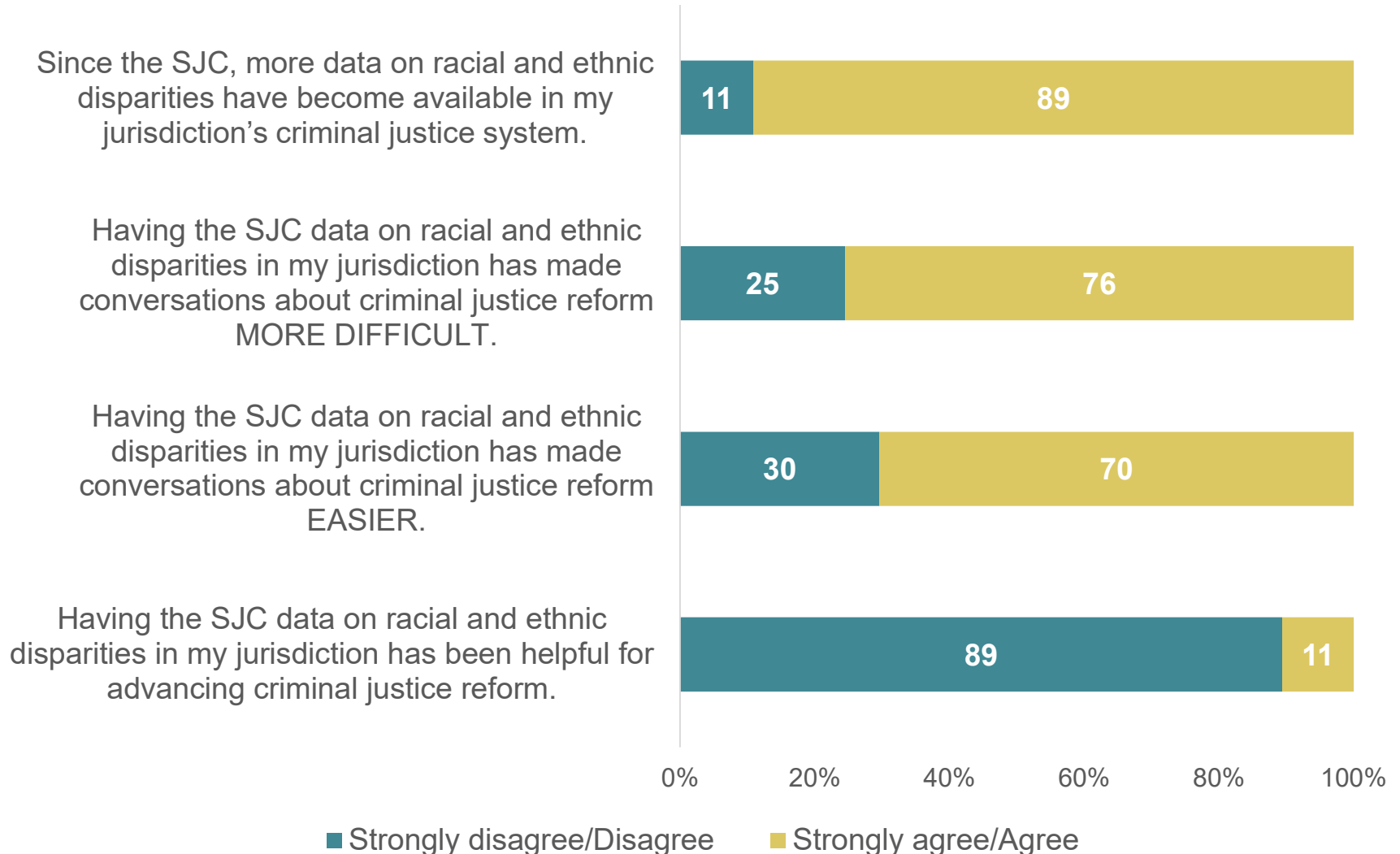

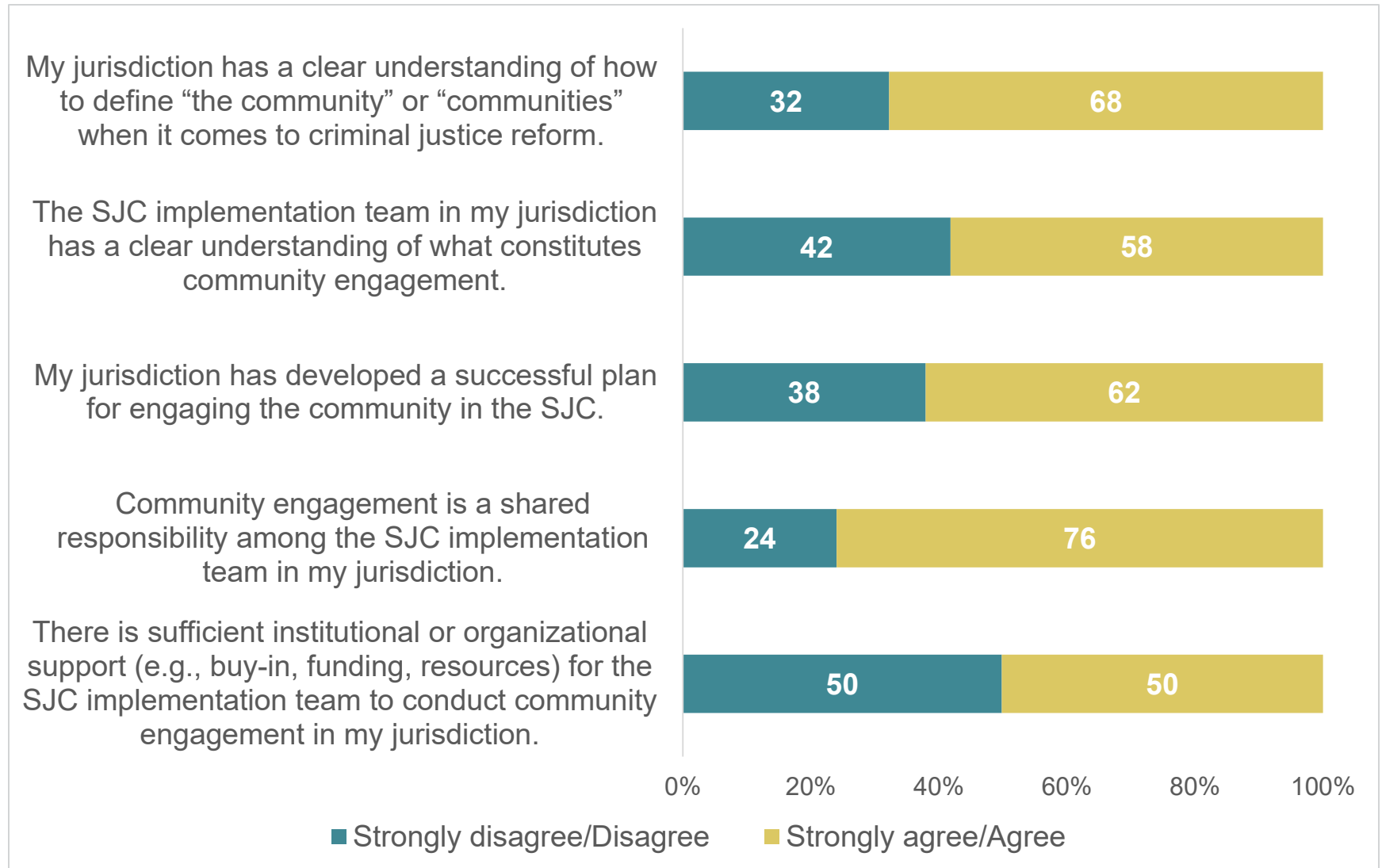

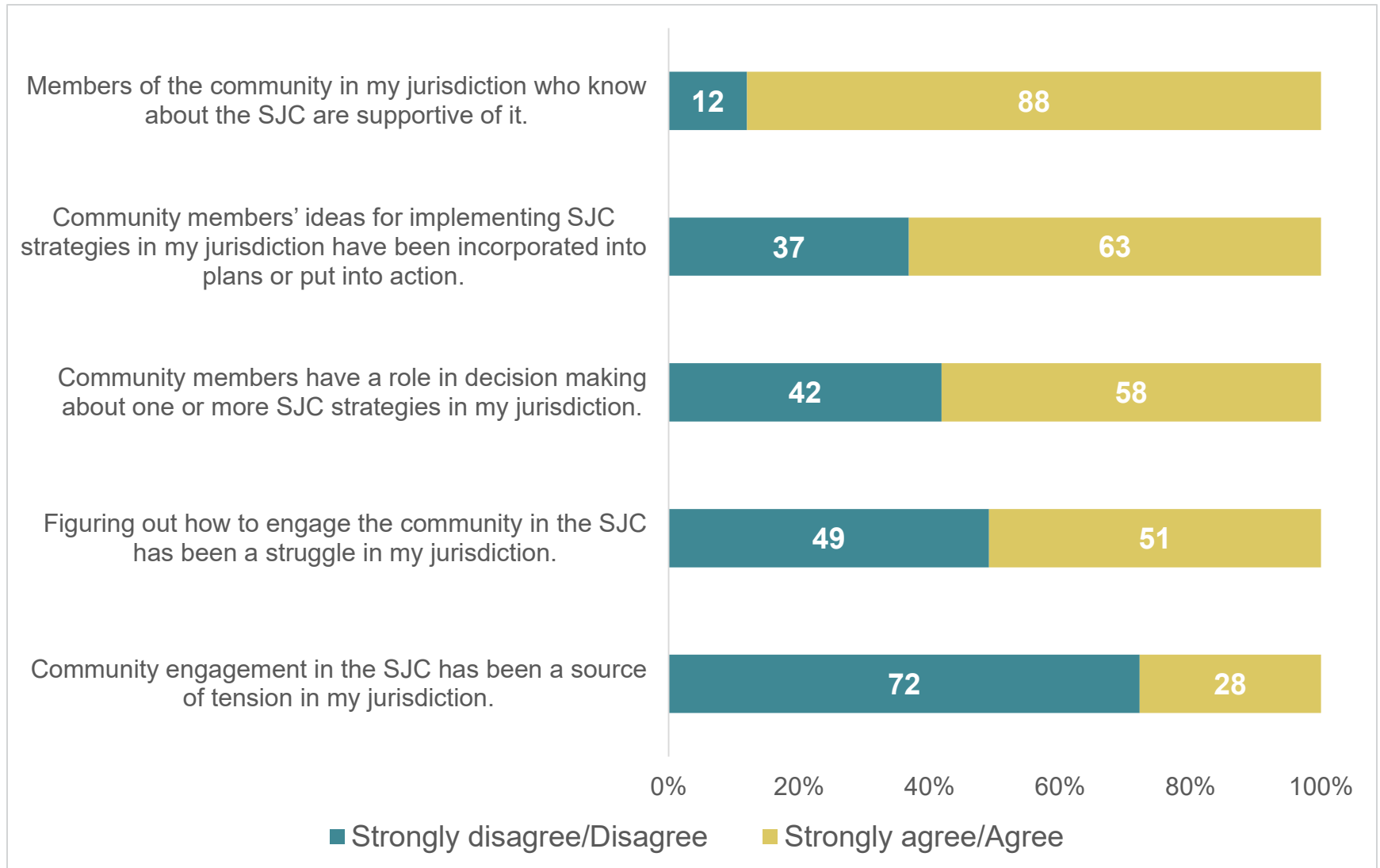

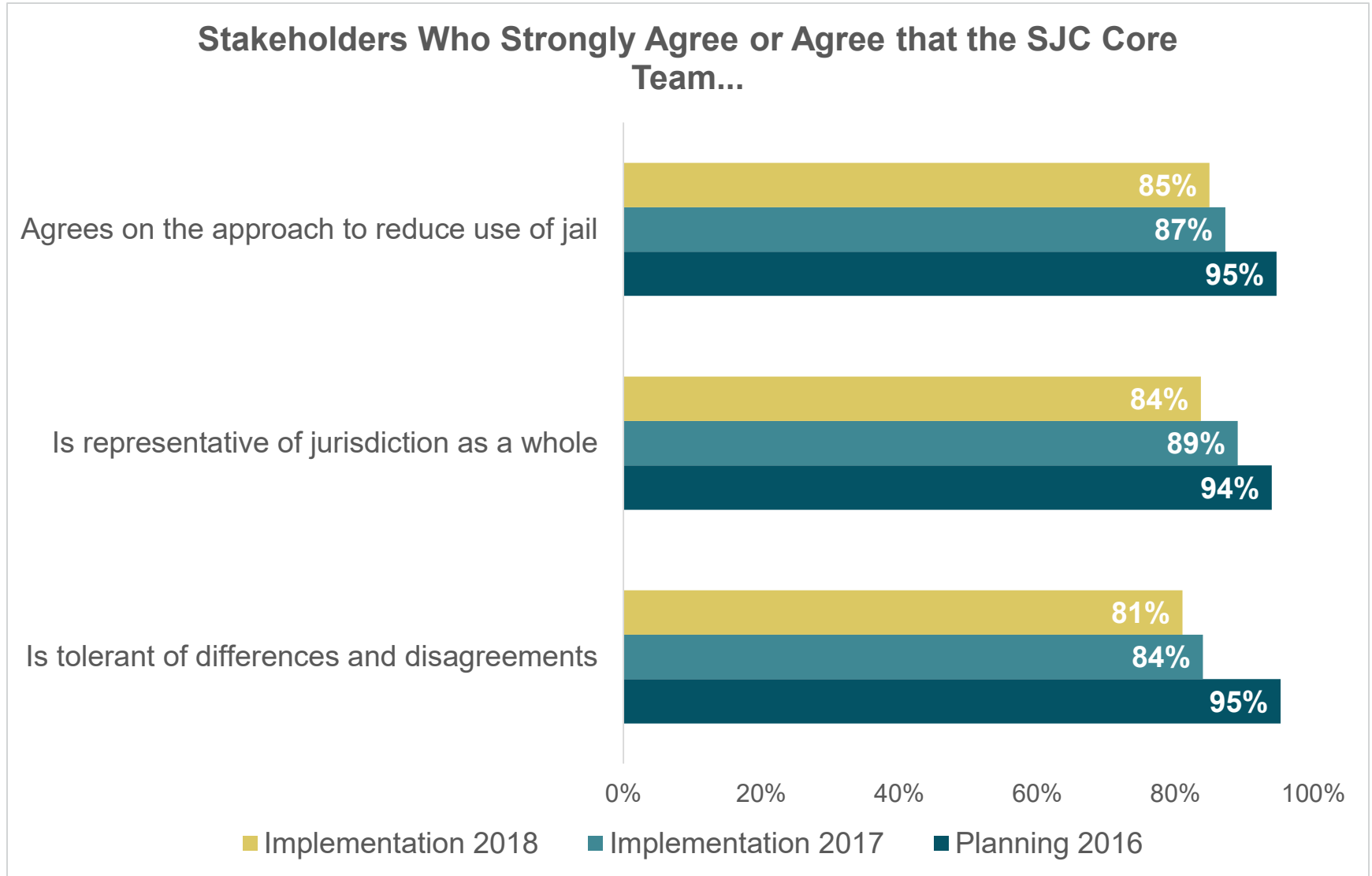

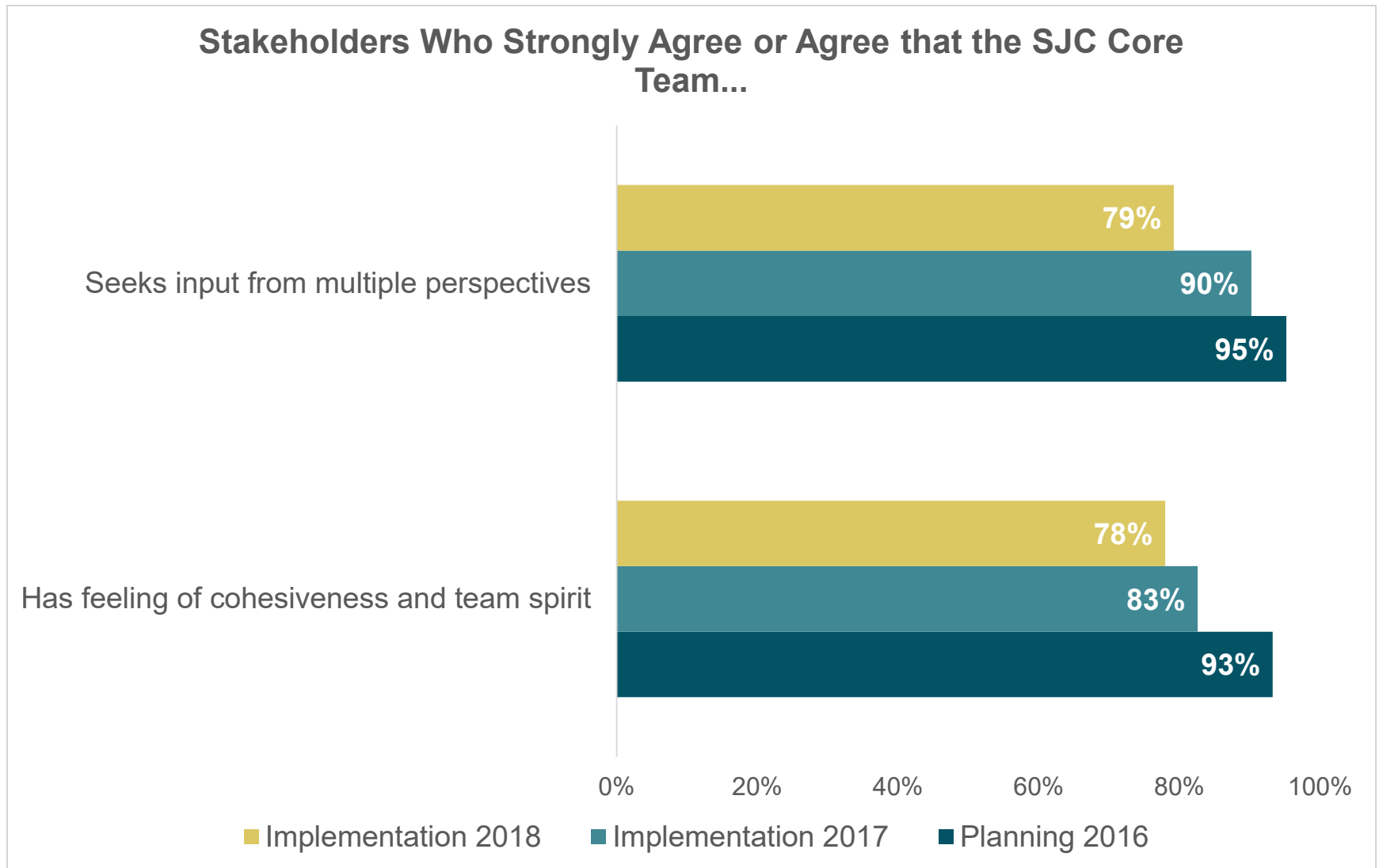

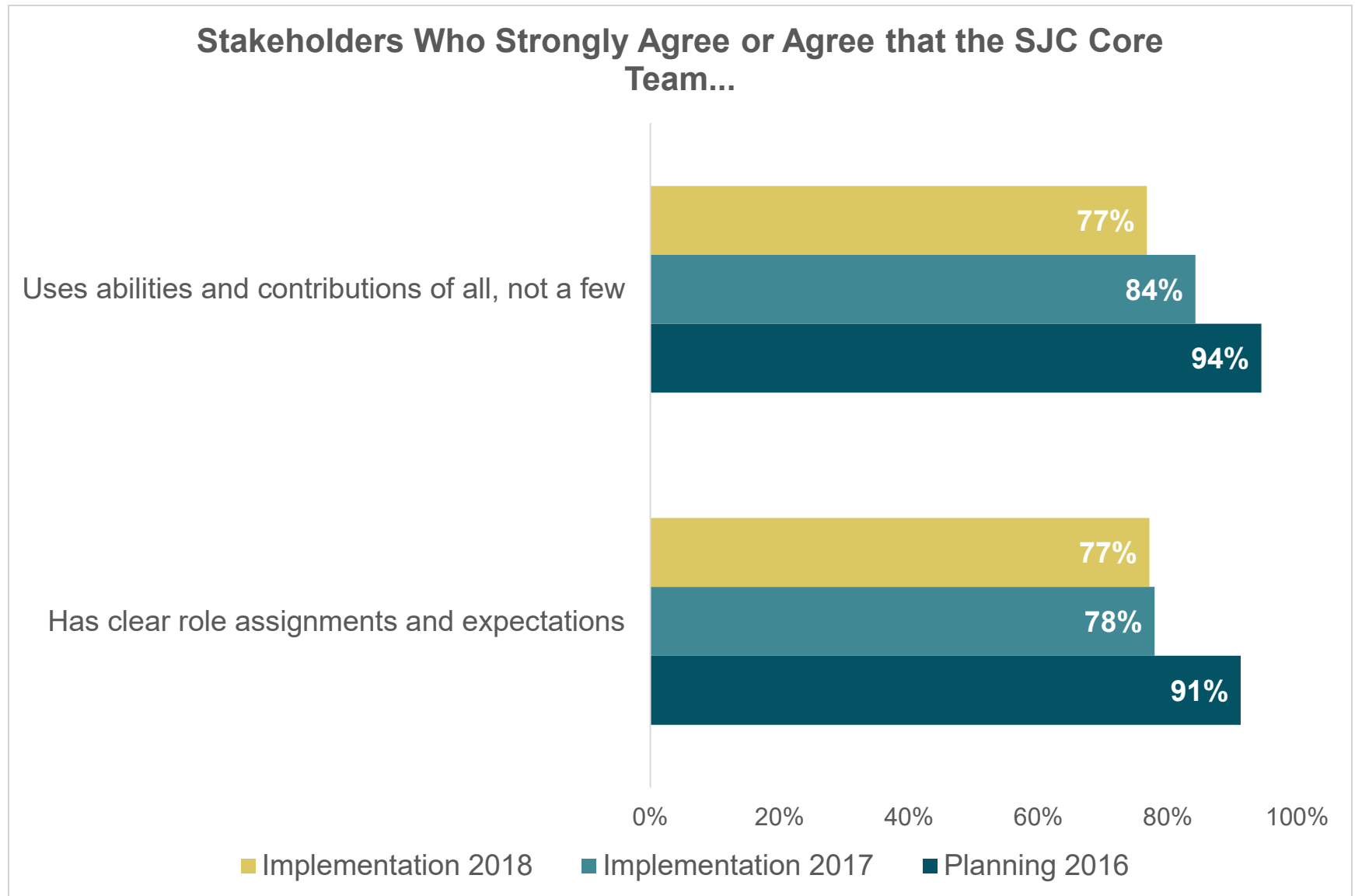

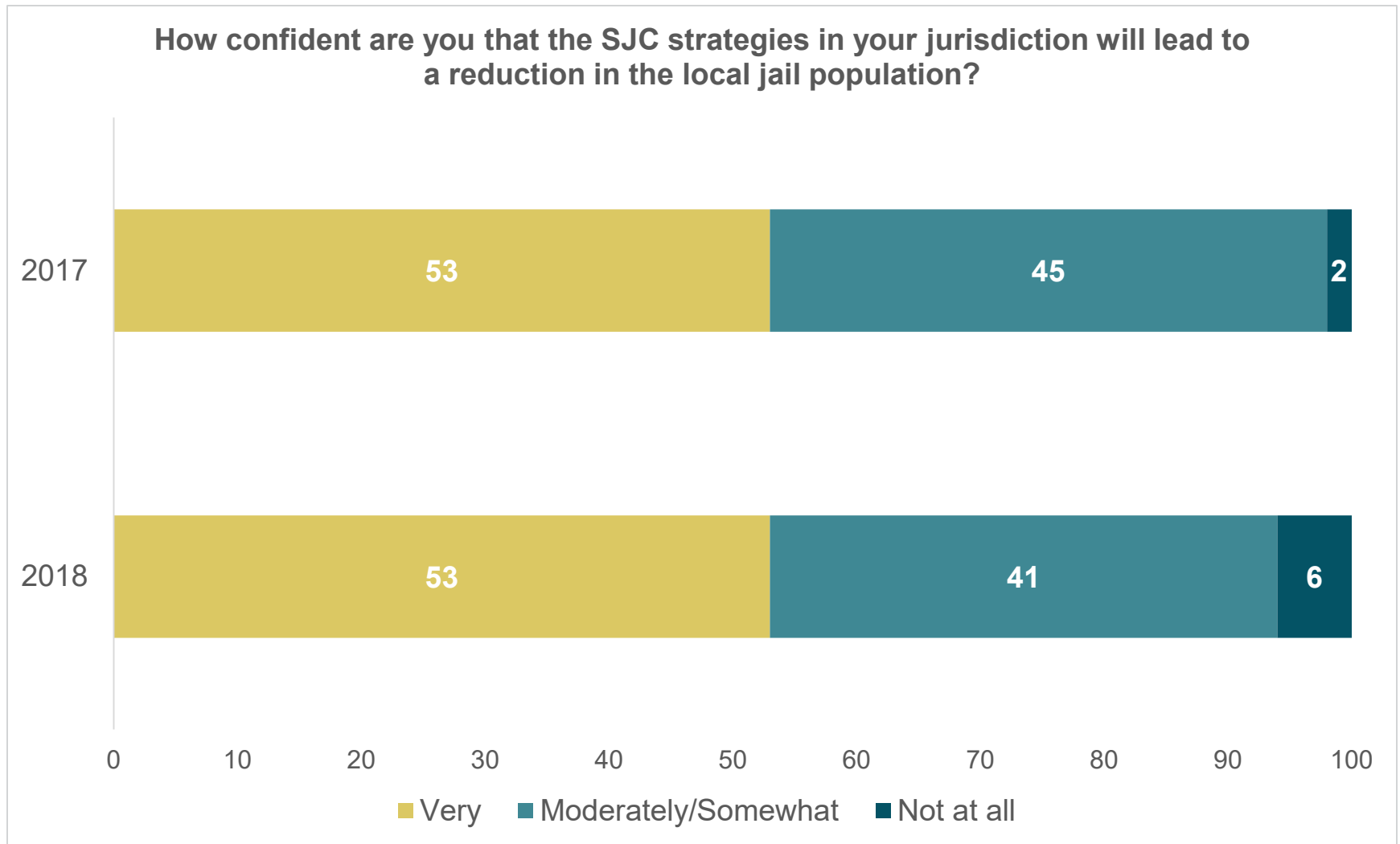

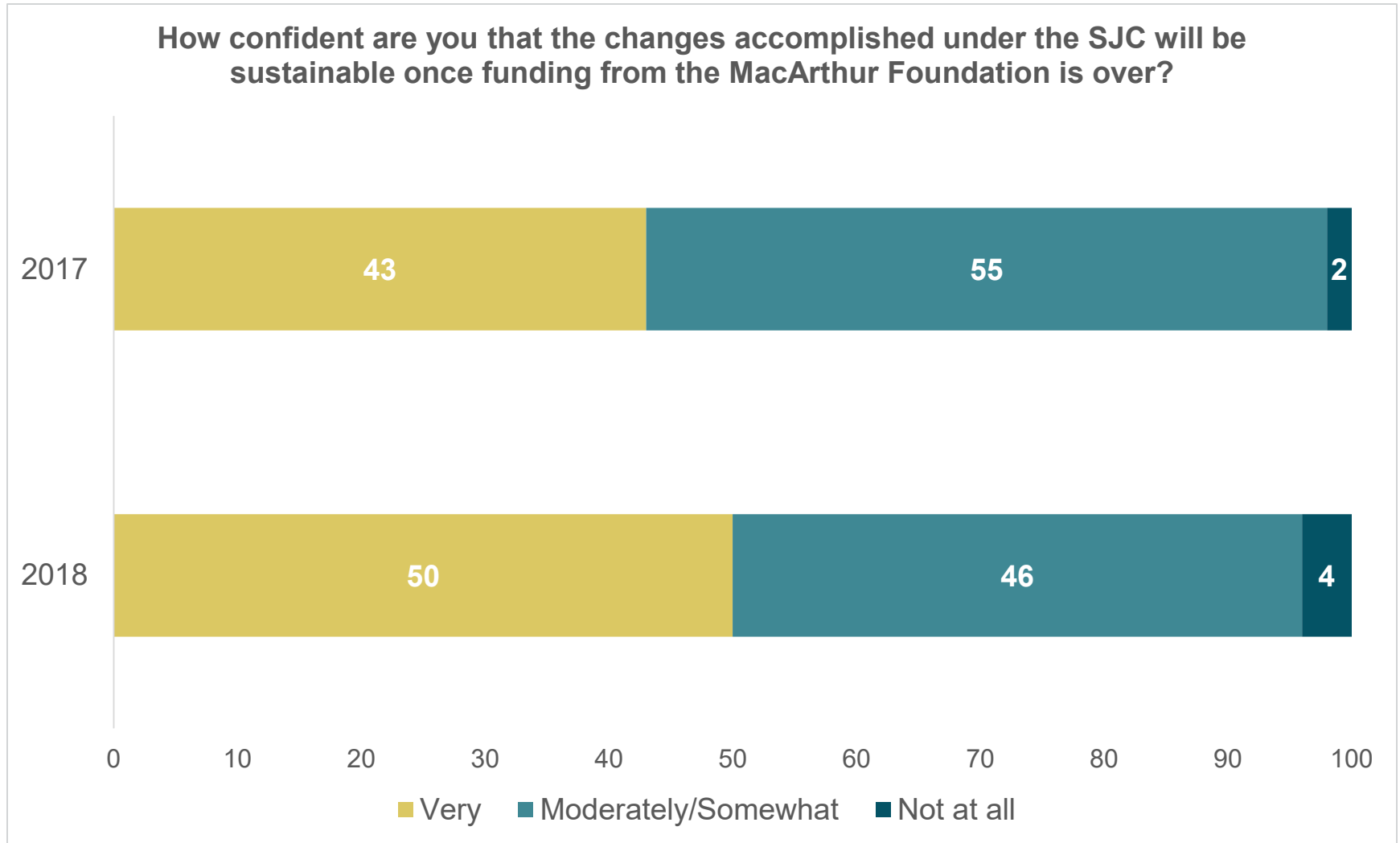

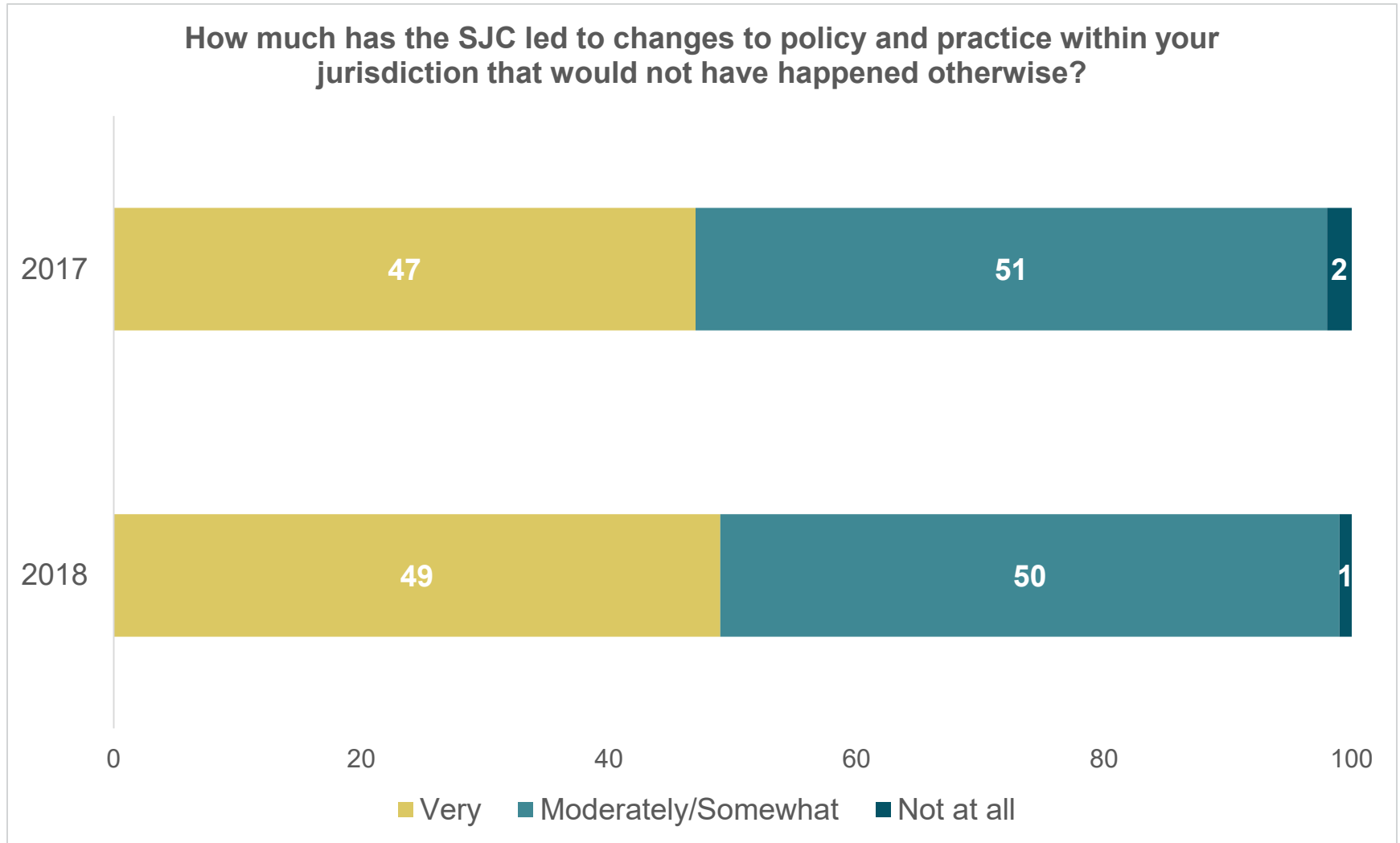
Overall Impressions of the SJC: 2017 vs. 2018



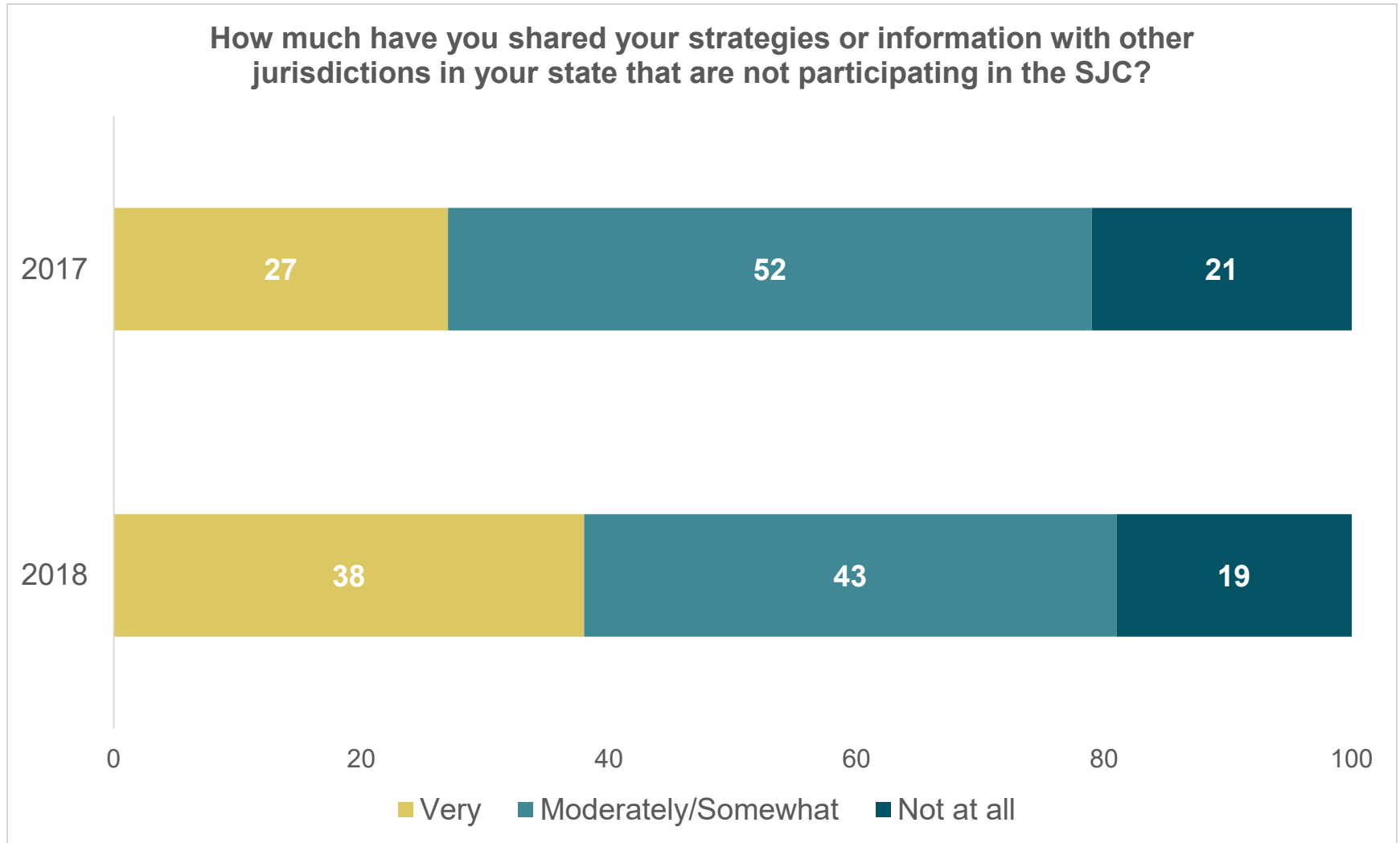
