STRATEGIES FOR REDUCING JAIL USE: OFFICER BASED STRATEGIES

- ► Eliminate Automatic Holds
 - Officer discretion: based on risk of danger
- ▶ Re-engaging absconders
 - Utilizing State Code which allows for 90 days before mandated revocation proceedings
- Addressing co-terminus sentences
 - ▶ Officers recommending alternatives to these dispositions

STRATEGIES FOR REDUCING JAIL USE: POLICY BASED STRATEGIES

- ▶ 10% reduction in overall Petitions to Revoke
 - Reliance on sanctions and evidence based practices such as EPICS
- Revised addendum process to expedite the disposition process
- ► Elimination of PROJECT SAFE
 - Know when to abandon programs that are not working
- ▶ Use of GPS monitoring rather than jail sanctions

STRATEGIES FOR REDUCING JAIL USE: PROGRAM BASED STRATEGIES

- Warrant Resolution Program
 - Resolve absconder warrants through the court without arrest
- Housing program for justice involved individuals
 - Two to three weeks paid funding at sober living environments with Macarthur funding
- Cell phones for probationers without access to communication
- Cab rides for probationers without transportation
- Grant funds for drug testing
 - Funding from CUNY Institute for State and Local Governance
 - Partnered with National Center for State Courts for research purposes
- Participation in an inter-agency Jail Population Review Committee
